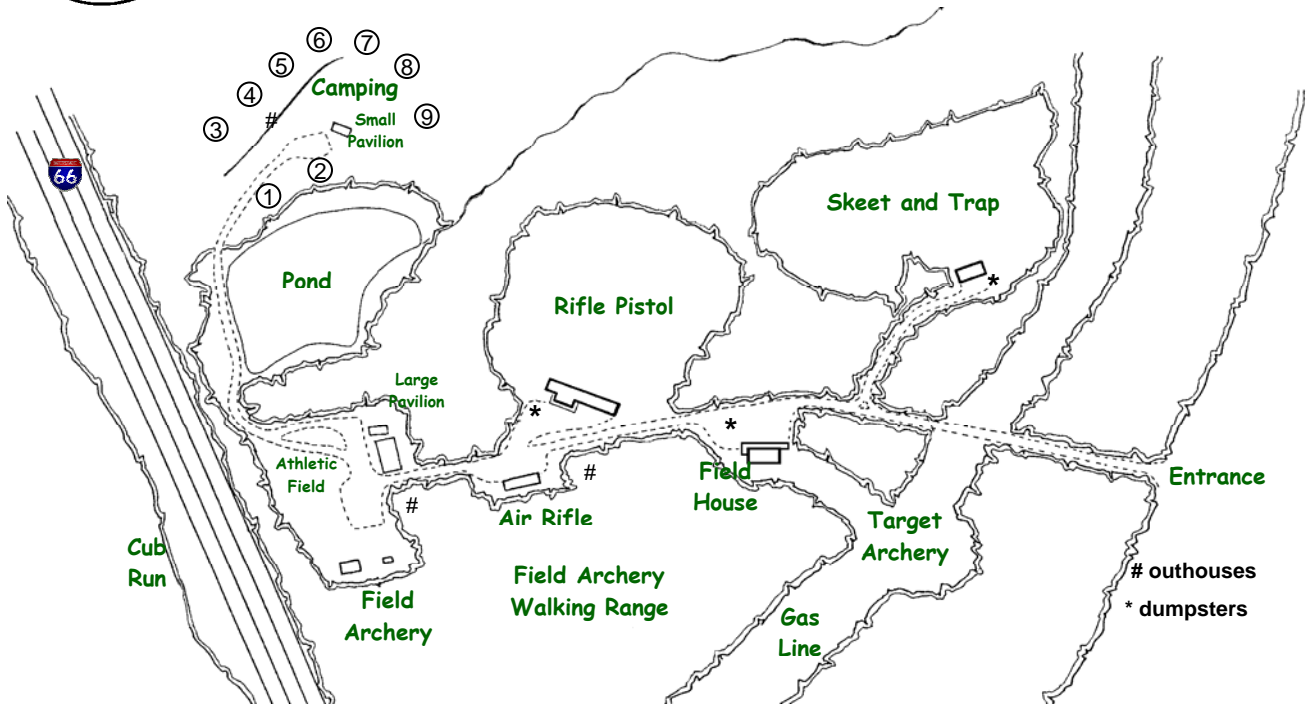

GROUND RULES

- All persons or groups using the campsites or any other chapter facilities shall do so at their own risk and hold the Arlington-Fairfax Chapter, its officers and assigns indemnified from any personal injury as a result of such camping, picnicking, partying and/or other activities.
- The entire property is a designated conservation area and wildlife sanctuary. Killing or molestation of birds, animals or their habitat is prohibited. Live trees, shrubbery or plants shall not be cut, damaged, destroyed or removed from the property; except by authorization of the Board of Directors and Conservation Officer.
- All refuse shall be bagged and carried to the dumpster at the Rifle/Pistol Range or the field house.
- The Chapter shall not be responsible for any personal property.
- Firearms are not allowed in any area except under the direct supervision of a qualified range officer at the ranges designated for their use.
- Campsites are subject to inspection by Chapter Directors, Officers and our Caretaker.
- Observe all posted rules
- All dogs shall be on leash. No animals allowed into chapter buildings unless approved by the Board of Directors, service animals excepted.
- All persons under 18 years of age will be under the direct supervision of a responsible adult while on Chapter property.
- All personnel and groups will confine their activities to the camping areas, picnic areas, nature trail, roads and the athletic fields and stay out of the Target Archery Range, Archery Field Range, Rifle-Pistol Range backstop, and Skeet-Trap shot fall areas unless specifically engaged in an activity in those areas.
- **All trash will be bagged and placed in one of the dumpsters. No trash will be left in any of the cans.**

CAMPING

- All camping shall be at designated campsites.
- No campsite shall be closer than 50 feet to the edge of the pond.
- Each group shall be responsible for keeping their campsite clean and orderly.
- Campfires are restricted to fire pits previously constructed at each site.
- No house trailers or motor campers are allowed across the dam.
- Use only the existing outhouses and bathrooms. No latrines shall be constructed.
- Any tentage or equipment left unattended for a period longer than 24 hours may be confiscated and become the property of the Chapter.

POND

- All persons using the area around the pond shall do so at their own risk.
- Absolutely no swimming or ice-skating is allowed.
- No sticks, stones, cans or other debris shall be thrown into the pond or onto the ice in winter.

MOTOR VEHICLES

- Operators of all vehicles on Chapter property shall observe a speed limit of 10 mph.
- Parking is permitted only in designated parking areas or as specifically approved by Chapter officials in charge of a particular activity.
- Vehicles over 10,000-lbs. gross vehicle weight are not permitted to cross the dam.

CONSERVATION FIELD HOUSE

The premises must be left clean with all trash bagged and carried to the dumpster.

FAILURE TO OBEY THESE GROUND RULES

Chapter Officers (including Range Officers) and our Caretaker have the authority to expel any person or group acting in any way contrary to these Ground Rules.
